




FUN FACTS ABOUT THE PIPE ORGAN



- ★ The organ has been around since the 3rd century BC... that's almost 2300 years ago!
- ★ You probably think of church music when you think of the organ, but it didn't start showing up in church until around the year 900 AD.
- ★ The organ is played with both your hands AND your feet!



SAMUEL COLERIDGE-TAYLOR (1875-1912)




- English composer, who was the son of a black man and a white woman.
